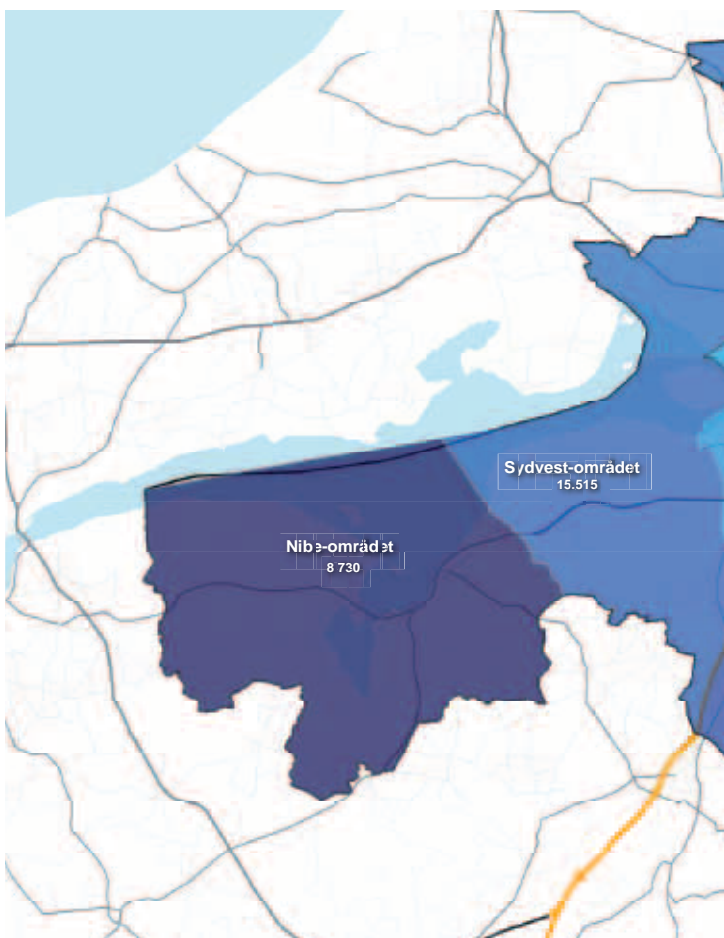

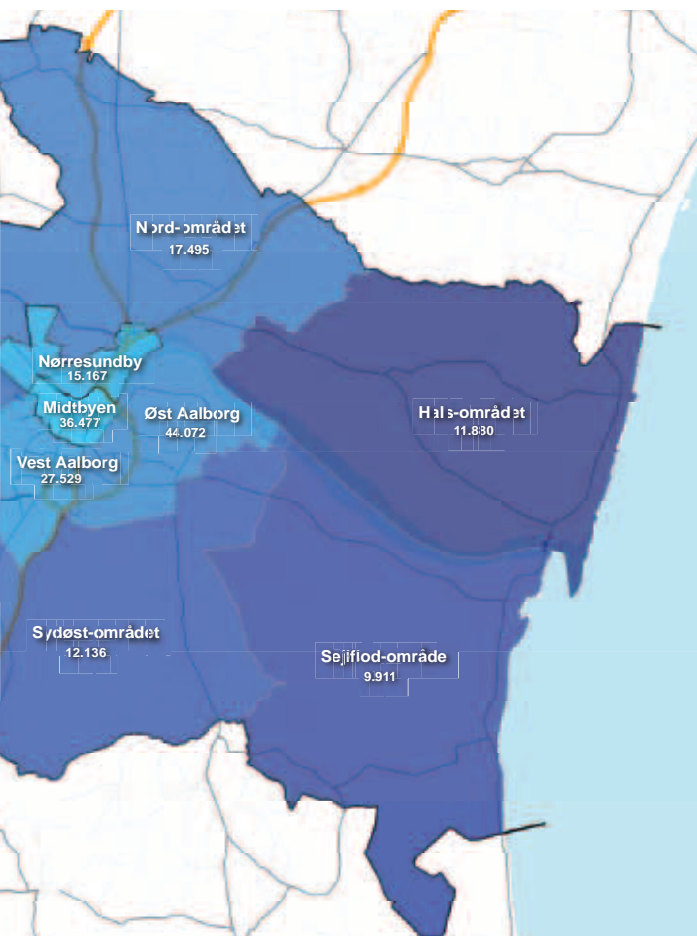


Preface

More detailed information is available via the Aalborg municipality's website www.aalborgkommune.dk the facts about the municipality or by contacting the Economic Office, Mayor's Management.

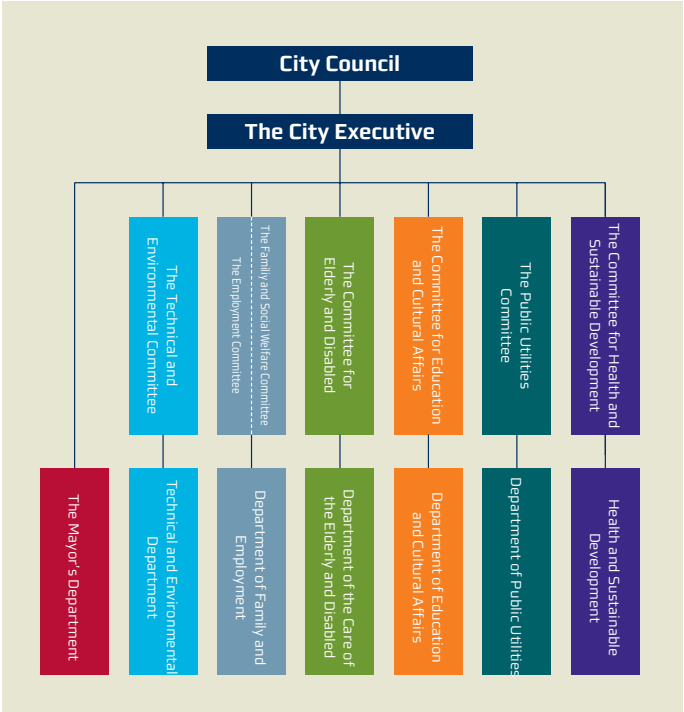

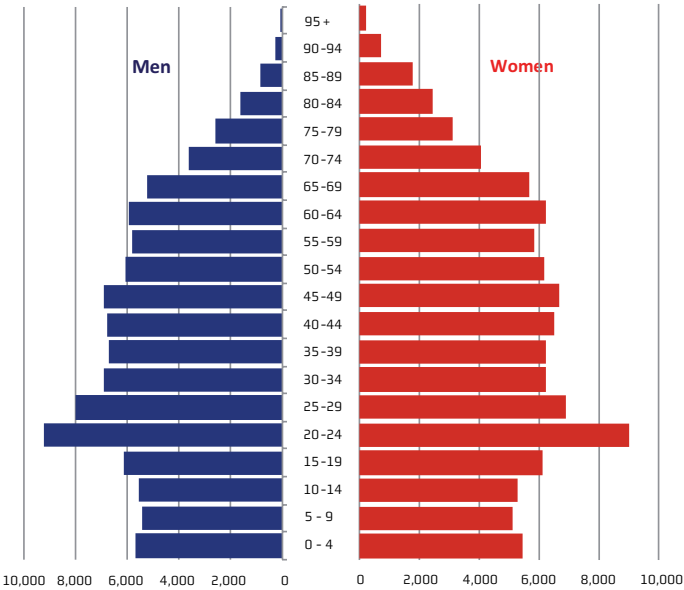

Population by age and gender on 1 January 2011



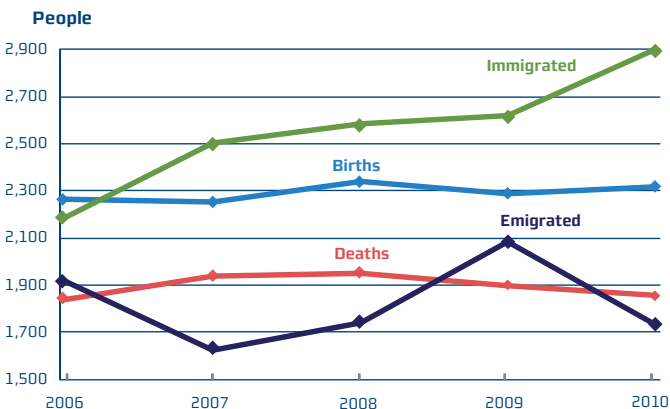

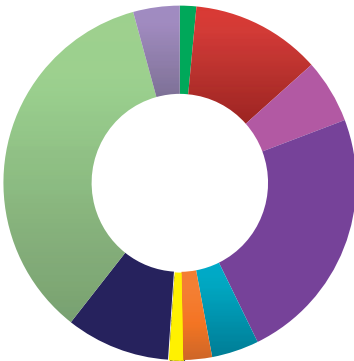

Day population by industry 2009



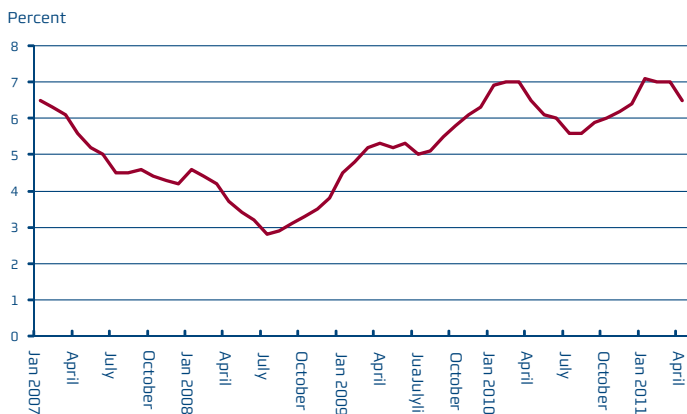

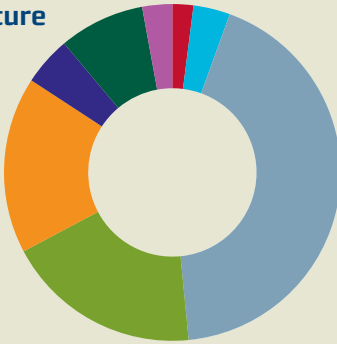

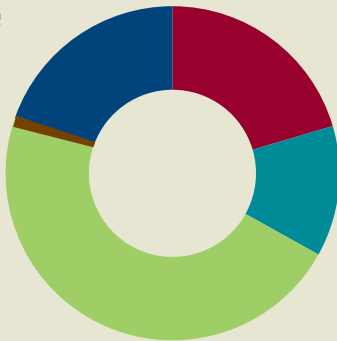
