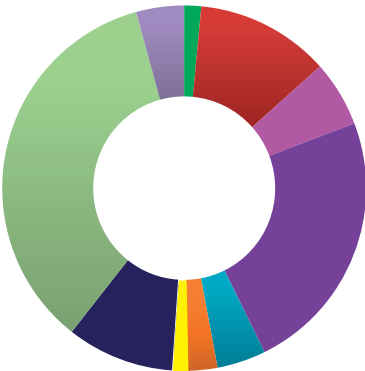

Day population by industry 2009



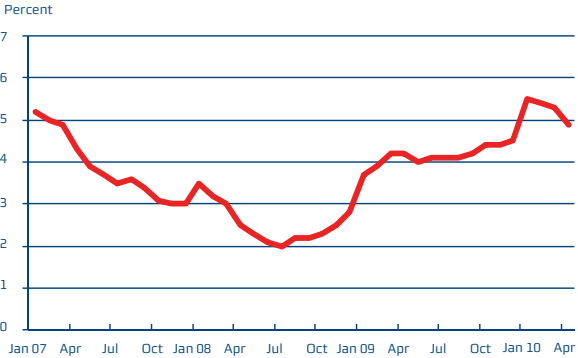

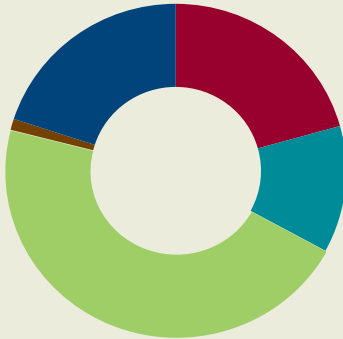
